WHAT ARE VOCs?

Volatile Organic Compounds, or VOCs, are chemicals, or chemical combinations we don't want to be breathing.

Recent studies (and your own experience) tell us that we spend most of our time indoors, up to 90%! It's important to know what you are breathing.

The EPA tells us that indoor air can have 100 times the chemicals that outdoor air has.







Health issues

If you are suffering from headaches, insomnia, brain fog, asthma, sore throats, lung issues, or fatigue that you can't seem to shake and have been to the doctors many times but can't seem to get better, there could be a possible link to your environment. Children are most vulnerable as their organs are still developing.

NEWER HOMES

Building materials can off-gas creating hazardous indoor air quality that could cause people to feel unwell. Many new building materials contain formaldehyde and other plastic chemicals that can off-gas for years.

Possible Sources

- chemical adhesives
- oil based or acrylic VOC paint
- pre-enginneered wood flooring and cabinetry
- synthetic carpeting loaded with chemicals
- insufficient ventilation and filtration
- electrostatic cleaners on furnaces
- energy efficient homes too tightly sealed
- stove fans that don't vent outside

Luxury vinyl tile is a new culprit of off gassing formaldehyde. There's nothing luxurious about feeling sick from your new flooring. It can also off gas for up to 15 years!







Older Homes

Possible Sources

- drainage issues around home
- mold
- condensation on windows
- old carpeting
- oil based or acrylic VOC paint
- · windows painted shut
- smoke from previous owners
- poor ventilation
- · dirty vents that haven't been cleaned
- · air conditioning units that haven't been serviced
- no insulation or old insulation
